Back of replica says (in part): “The Kennett Consolidated School had its beginning in 1930 when the borough and three adjoining school districts decided to consolidate, closing all of the one room schools. It was erected at a cost of \$1,250,000. Mr. Pierre S. DuPont of Longwood was a huge supporter and benefactor – both at the school’s inception and later when population growth made additions necessary. ... the first graduating class of 1932 had fifty-nine seniors.
